NEW GRANTS AWARDED!



Philip A. Efron, MD, FACS. Assistant Professor, Department of Surgery has been awarded a National Institutes of Health R01 grant entitled, "Hematopoietic stem cell dysfunction in the elderly after severe injury".

Lizi Wu, PhD. Assistant Professor, Department of Molecular genetics & Microbiology as been awarded

a National Institutes of Health R21 grant entitled, "A novel noncoding RNA and human lung cancers with inactivated LKB1 signaling".

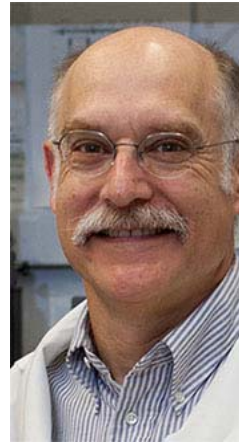

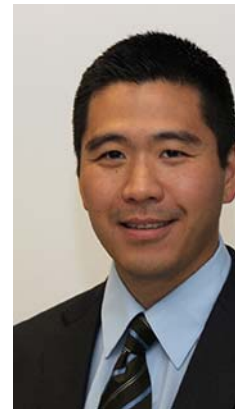
Ashley Brown, PhD. Department of Medicine has been selected as one of the 2015 recipients of the UF Excellence Awards for Assistant Professor.

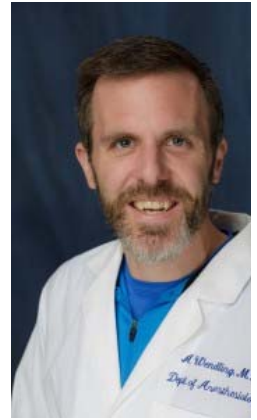
