

Create a Web of Science profile (Online)

Friday, Aug 4, 12-12:30pm

This session will show you how to create your researcher profile in Web of Science. Part of the 20 Minutes to Impact series where you will learn about a research impact metric or tool and receive step-by-step instructions which you can actively follow to accomplish an impact-related task by the end of the workshop.

Research Integrity Issues Related to Publishing: Author responsibilities (Online) *Friday, August 18, 12-1pm*

This session will discuss issues related to research integrity and the publication of journal articles. Topics will include authorship issues such as guest and ghost authors, complete and transparent reporting of trials, conflicts of interest including any role the sponsor played in deciding what to publish, and predatory publishing. We will look at some cases of misconduct and the repercussions, such as retractions, loss of funding, and damage to public trust in the research enterprise. The focus will be on resources that can inform ethical practices, such as ICMJE authorship criteria, reporting guidelines, and tools to help identify credible journals. https://libcal.uflib.ufl.edu/calendar/HSCLWorkshops/Integrity

Searching PubMed (Online)

Thursday, August 10, 11-12pm

This class will take you step-by-step through effective literature search and save techniques—starting smartly, limiting efficiently without losing "good stuff", searching for specific info (authors, types of publications, specific journals) and refining your search. Depending on participant interests/needs and time, we may also cover setting up email alerts, transferring to bibliographic software like Mendeley or EndNote, filtering for evidence-based studies, building collections within PubMed or other functions within PubMed.


